As a Configuration Management (CM) Specialist with Kraken Robotics you will play a key role in the support, definition, and maintenance of Kraken's product portfolio. The CM Specialist will be responsible for managing the baseline of Kraken's products, maintaining records of their variation within projects, and management of interactions between different disciplines and departments in support of product delivery. This individual will need to understand the "big picture" of how Kraken operates to properly support the definition of change related risks and should have a passion for the development of processes.

The Successful applicant will have excellent interpersonal skills, a passion for continual improvement, and an interest in understanding how business processes interact with Engineering, Production, Quality, and Supply Chain Management. This role can be based in Kraken's office in Mount Pearl, NL or Dartmouth, NS and will require regular travel to support operations in Kraken's entities outside of Canada.

- Support production and engineering through the build and management of products within projects, while maintaining the documentation related to Kraken's standard offerings.
